### 3 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2014-2016 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the International Pirate Class Rules and the Hungarian Yachting Association Sailing Instructions and Advertising Instructions. 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages, the Hungarian text will take precedence.

### 4 ADVERTISEMENT

- 4.1 Competitor advertising shall comply with RRS 80 and ISAF Regulation 20.  
4.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 5 REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT

- 5.1 Preregistration: via mail to Mr. Miklós Dárdai [dardai.miklos@kereked.com](mailto:dardai.miklos@kereked.com) until July 5<sup>th</sup>, please also give the size of the team for t-shirt.  
5.2 Venue: Kereked Vitorlás Klub (Csopak, Örkény István sétány 14.)  
5.3 Time: 12:00-20:00 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2015 and  
8:00-9:00 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2015

In the given measurement period only checking measurement will take place, all sails will be checked and stamped. You can only enter the competition with a measured hull and stamped sails. During the regatta measurement check may occur. You must show the boat's measurement form at registration or registration will not be valid. You must show the boat's insurance form at registration or registration will not be valid.

- 5.4 Entry fee: HUF 13,000/person. This only applies to the members of the Hungarian Pirate Class Association, that is, who have paid the membership fee of the Association. If the payment has not been made, the participants will have the opportunity to pay the fee at the entry. The minimum membership fee is HUF 2000 /person, but higher contributions are also accepted on voluntary basis.

5.5 For those born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1997 the entry fee is HUF 6500. For them the minimum membership fee is HUF 1500.

## 6 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS, SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

6.1 Information will be posted on the official notice board on the window of the race office in the form of written notices.

6.2 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag pole in front of the race office.

## 7 PROGRAMME

7.1 Opening Ceremony and Competitors meeting will be at 9.00 July 26<sup>th</sup> 2015.

7.2 The race committee is planning to sail 12 races as follows:

July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015                      3 races

July 27<sup>st</sup>, 2015                      3 races

July 28<sup>st</sup>, 2015                      3 races

July 29<sup>st</sup>, 2015                      3 races

July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015                      reserve day in case of less than 10 races done

7.3 The time of the first warning signal will be July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014 10:55. On the further days the time of the warning signal will be 09:55. Race Committee will post the next days any changes on the prior day latest 20.00 on the official notice board.

7.4 If the planned number of races can't be completed by the end of the 2nd scheduled racing day, then on the following days 4 races may be sailed in case of appropriate wind conditions.

7.5 On the last racing day, July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015, no starting procedure will be started after 15:00.

## 8. CLASS FLAG

The flag used at the championship will be a black class insignia on a white base.

## 9. RACING AREA AND RACE COURSE

9.1 A leeward-windward course will be set for each race in the Lake Balaton, which has to be sailed according to the course plan in Appendix 1.

9.2 Course marks 1 and 2 have to be taken from the left hand side.

9.3 At the end of the first leeward leg, the marks make up a gate 4s,p .If one of the marks of the gate is missing, the mark in its place have to be taken from the left hand side.

9.4 Target time and time limits

Target time	Time limit at mark 1	Time limit for the boat finishing first	Finish window
60	30	90	20

The times in the chart are given in minutes. The chart changes Rule 13.2 of the Hungarian Yachting Association Sailing Instructions.

Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes Rule 62.1.

If the first boat does not finish the first leg or the race within the time limit, the race committee will abandon the race.

Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a protest hearing. This changes Rules 35, A4 and A5.

## **10. COURSE MARKS**

10.1 Course marks will be inflated yellow cylindrical buoys.

10.2 The starting and finishing marks will bear bright orange flags.

## **11. COMMITTEE BOATS**

11.1 Committee boats will display a white RC flag.

11.2 Jury boats will display a flag with the word JURY.

11.3 Press and media boats will display a flag with the words PRESS or MEDIA.

11.4 No other boats will be allowed on the race course except for rescue operations.

## **12. SCORING**

12.1 A total of four races are required to be completed to constitute the championship.

12.2 (a) When less than five races have been completed, no score will be excluded.

(b) When from five to nine races have been completed one race score will be excluded.

(c) When ten or more races have been completed two race scores will be excluded.

## **13 PRIZES**

13.1 The prize giving ceremony will be held after the last race on the premises of the sailing club, in front of the club building.

13.2 Sailors finishing first to sixth will be awarded as International Pirate Championship and the best 1-6 Hungarian will be ranked in the Hungarian Pirate Championship.

## **14. LIABILITY**

The Kereked Vitorlás Klub and the Race Committee do not accept liability for loss of life, or property, or personal injury, or damage caused by or arising out of the regatta and competitors take part in the regatta at their own risk. ( see RRS 4.)

## **15. PARKING AND CAMPING**

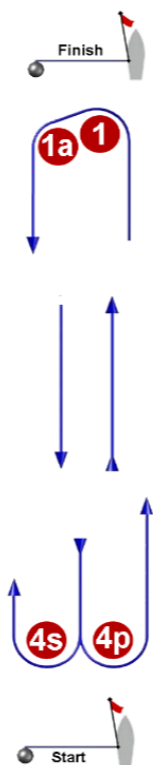
