Consistent thermal and geostrophic winds including the famous "Rosenwind" create fair racing conditions.

Situated between Salzburg and Vienna, lake Attersee is around the corner for most of the Pirat sailors.




# Championship Overview & Schedule

## Event Format

- 22-30 May 2027
- 9 days total: 2 registration, 2 training, 5 days racing.
- Over 80 boats competing.
- Up to 10 races with single discard.

- Official training camp: 23 -24 May 2027
- Live tracking by TracTrac
- Media coverage with drones
- Professional race management by Weyregg Yacht Club



## Air Travel

Convenient access via Salzburg Airport (SZG, 65km) and Linz Airport (LNZ, 80km).



## Ground Transport

Rail connections at Attnang - Puchheim station (25km), easy A1 West Autobahn access, and bus service.

1,200 beds within 10km radius including hotels, guesthouses and apartments. Camping site near the club.
